

The Foiling Around Tournament

The Foiling Around Tournament is a fun co-ed foil team event for fencers of all ages and all levels of achievement. And it's even sanctioned by the Ontario Fencing Association but this is not a points gathering event. Teams will be randomly made up of one fencer from each group – the Good, the Better, and the Best. Each team fences the other teams in the tableau. Each of these pools consists of 9 individual bouts of 5 touches. This is a self refereeing event, however the medal rounds will be refereed by a qualified individual. Medals will be awarded to the top three teams.

When is this happening?

It happens on Saturday, August 29, 2009. Registration closes at 9:00 a.m. in the morning, so don't sleep in! Fencing will commence real soon after the close of registration.

Where is this happening?

It takes place in the Upper Gymnasium in the Ryerson Athletic Complex at Ryerson University in Toronto, Ontario. Enter from Gould Street.

How much is it?

Really cheap! The entry fee is the bargain basement price of only \$25 Canadian! Sorry, but we're only accepting cash.

What equipment do I need?

You will need to outfit yourself with all that electric foil stuff. We won't be able to provide it for you. And remember safety! No unsafe equipment or shorts will be allowed. Masks will be checked.
