GENERAL

OFA competitive membership plus valid CFF membership required (not available at venue).

All fencers are subject to Article t.15 of the FIE Rules and Regulations.

Masks and other equipment will be checked on the piste.

Regular fencing attire required including sous plastron. You can wear track/sweat pants, but no lycra.

Points count towards CFF Domestic rankings.

VENUE

Yuill Gym, St. Andrew's College, Aurora

LOCATION

The tournament will be held at the Yuill Gym, St. Andrew's College, 15800 Yonge Street in Aurora, only 25 km north of Toronto.

DIRECTIONS

From the 401, take 404 north. Exit at Mulock and turn west towards Newmarket. Stay on Mulock until you reach Yonge. Turn left (south) on Yonge, and go past St. John's Side Road. St. Andrew's College is at the next set of traffic lights on the right (west) across from the Auto Mall.

If coming from the 401 west, take 400 north. Exit at highway 9, Orangeville and Newmarket exit. Go right (east) until you reach Yonge. Turn right (south) on Yonge, and go past St. John's Side Road. St. Andrew's College is at the next set of traffic lights on the right (west) across from the Auto Mall.
